Minutes of last meeting	The minutes (10.01.2023) were approved.
Thermal Imaging Camera – planning the details.	<p>The uptake for the camera has been very successful. 22 forms have been delivered and 17 forms have been returned. We are not taking anymore bookings for this service.</p> <p>Nicola has organised for Sandlings properties (SEH French group). They will come on Earth Day and give advice on the thermal imaging from the cameras.</p> <p>The temperature difference is crucial or we will not be giving accurate information, this means that we may not be able to go ahead with the survey.</p> <p>People have been informed about this in the hope that expectations will be managed if we cannot go ahead.</p> <p>If it goes well, we will ask for it again next year but at a different time of the year where the weather will be more suitable.</p> <p>We need commitment to carry out the training and the surveys- March 22nd-2nd April Looking at 8pm onwards for the survey. Amanda will send round a timetable for people to sign up.</p> <p>We get the machine on Tuesday 21st and we can use it at the community centre to see how the unit works.</p>

The walk about was discussed and our notes will be shared- John M.</p>

	<p>Andy raised that the charging point at the lake will be disconnected as per the orders of Mid Suffolk District Council. John to investigate as to why this is.</p> <p>Also discussed having the appropriate charging points in the appropriate places- at the Co-op having a 7kw charger is pointless as it charges so slowly.</p>
AOB	<p>Network Rail have offered some mature hedging to compensate for hedging which was removed. The location has been decided upon – near the mound and mature trees in Crowley park. This will create an area which could be used for other CAG projects.</p> <p>Vertas will keep it watered for the first year.</p>
